

4th TAN CHIN TUAN NURSING AWARD for enrolled nurses 2010

SingHealth is proud to present the Tan Chin Tuan Nursing Award, an award open to enrolled nurses of healthcare institutions, hospitals and nursing homes in Singapore.

This nation-wide nursing award aims to recognise promising and talented enrolled nurses who are dedicated to advancing the nursing profession locally.

Who is eligible for the award?

Nominees should be trained enrolled nurses, who are currently in full-time service at a local healthcare institution, with at least 5 years post-qualification nursing experience.

Nominations are open to all public and private healthcare institutions in Singapore, including hospitals, national specialty centres, polyclinics, and nursing homes.

How will the award winners be selected?

Nominees will be short-listed based on established criteria. The final short-listed nominees will be requested to submit an essay that encapsulates their vision of tomorrow's nursing profession, including what is required to advance the profession and the role they envision for themselves.

They will then be interviewed by an independent panel comprising leaders from healthcare, academia and the community.

How many awards will be given out?

A total of 3 awards will be presented. Each winner will receive a specially minted Florence Nightingale medallion and a S\$2,000 cash prize earmarked for their further professional development. The top winner will also receive a special Challenge Trophy, kept by the recipient institution for a year.
