#### ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Simulated participants (SPs) are individuals trained to support the learning or assessment of healthcare professionals and students. They may also support learning for organisations in terms of identifying human experiences of service processes. SPs can take on a variety of roles such as patients, relatives, bystanders, healthcare professionals, other staff and students in a simulated scenario, and can be crucial in developing the communication, professional and other behavioural skills of learners. Through the simulation experience and feedback offered by the SPs, learners are able to gain better understanding of the way they communicate and work with others, as well as areas for improvement. This workshop provides participants with foundational concepts and practices for working with SPs.

- Discuss contemporary issues in SP methodology
- Outline the components of an SP programme
- Design roles for SPs to support learning of healthcare professionals or students
- Identify approaches to support SPs in role portrayal

- Articulate the roles and responsibilities of faculty in SP methodology
