SYNOPSIS

The adoption of Pharmacogenomics (PGx) testing beyond single drug-gene pairs by healthcare systems has been slow due to many existing barriers, including the need for more evidence for clinical utility, incorporation of PGx information into current clinical workflow, and a lack of training for many clinicians to be able to interpret genomic test results.

This webinar will highlight the current integration of PGx in the clinical setting and update on the outcomes-based research in this area. A/Prof Wee Hwee Lin will discuss the cost-effectiveness of a panel-based PGx testing, citing data from international and local studies.
