## ABOUT THE EVENT

Recent data has shown that the global burden of cardiovascular disease has shifted to Asia, where cardiovascular risk management is urgently needed. Currently, decisions regarding the initiation and optimisation of therapy for the prevention of cardiovascular disease are made through the assessment of traditional risk factors. Though current risk scoring systems for cardiovascular disease prevention are widely available and easy to use, they were largely derived in white populations and may over- or under- estimate risk in other ethnic groups. Newer risk assessment tools may permit earlier and more targeted intervention. This symposium provides a timely update on novel circulating and imaging biomarkers for cardiovascular risk stratification with perspectives from Asia. Furthermore, the symposium will cover important updates on cardiovascular risk management in high risk groups (women and patients with diabetes).
