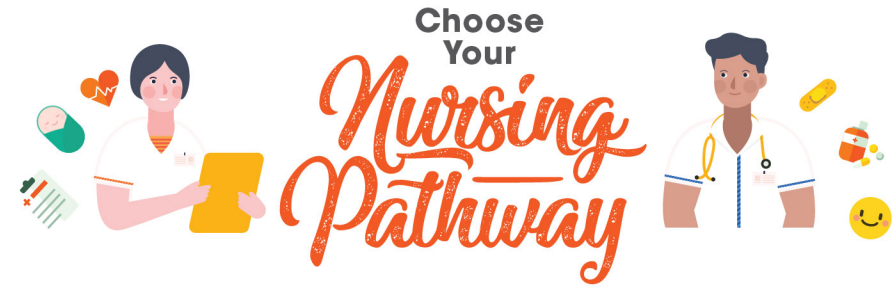

SCH oversees the management of Bright Vision Hospital (BVH), Sengkang Community Hospital (SKCH) and Outram Community Hospital (OCH). Delivering person-centred care to achieve patients' health goals, our care teams help them go beyond recovery and integrate back into the community.



CGH is a public teaching hospital with over 1,000 beds serving a community of more than 1 million people in eastern Singapore.



NCCS is the region's leader in cancer care and treatment, with dedicated facilities for the pursuit of cancer treatment, research and education.



NNI is the national and regional centre of care for treatment, education and research in neuroscience. NNI offers over 20 clinical sub-specialties and treats a broad range of conditions affecting the brain, spine, nerves and muscles.



SHP provides primary healthcare services and plays an integral role in empowering patients, their families and the communities to take charge of their health and wellness by delivering seamless, person-centred and preventive healthcare.



Officially opened in 2019, SKH provides quality, accessible care and access to national specialty centres for residents in Northeast Singapore.



NDCS is a specialty centre for oral health, providing multi-disciplinary and integrated care for patients. It also trains dental professionals and conducts oral health research with local and international academic institutions.



SNEC provides specialised eye services in Singapore and has gained international recognition for its research and education in ophthalmology.

## Clinical

- Provide nursing care and counseling to patients/ caregivers
- Collaborate with specialty teams and department of Nursing Administration
- Develop, implement and evaluate patient care standards and guidelines and educational materials relevant to their specialty of practice
- Act as a liaison between patients and families and multi-disciplinary healthcare teams

## Research

- Conduct primary research studies, reviews and health technology assessments
- Facilitate the implementation of evidence-based practice
- Design research projects, garner resources for the work, perform data collection as well as present and publish research findings
- Coach other nurses in their research endeavours
- Communicate and liaise with research participants and multi-disciplinary teams

## Informatics

- Develop implementation plans for information systems and technologies to improve productivity in work processes and strengthen patient care
- Guide nurses in the clinical area on the use of information systems and technologies
- Monitor and evaluate information systems and technology outcomes and take timely intervention
- Serve as a liaison, administrator and preceptor for nurses and trainees for matters related to information technology

## Education

- Design and implement curricula courses and study programmes
- Supervise clinical instructors in conducting classroom teaching
- Mentor, support and nurture nursing students attached to the institutions
- Identify, analyse, plan, implement and evaluate the training activities to the effective delivery of training programmes

## Management

- Provide leadership and expertise to lead multi-disciplinary work groups and coordinate projects related to patient and staff safety and quality
- Drive and evaluate staff compliance to regulatory requirements
- Nurture and develop talent among staff and groom them for succession and leadership roles
- Collaborate with respective clinical Heads of Department to develop and align strategic objectives to optimise quality patient care

## Diagnostic Radiographer

Provide safe and accurate imaging examinations through a variety of imaging modalities and interventional procedures with radiation, ultrasound and magnetic fields

## Medical Social Worker

Provide psychosocial and emotional care to patients and their families, assisting them in accessing financial resources and community support to enhance their well-being



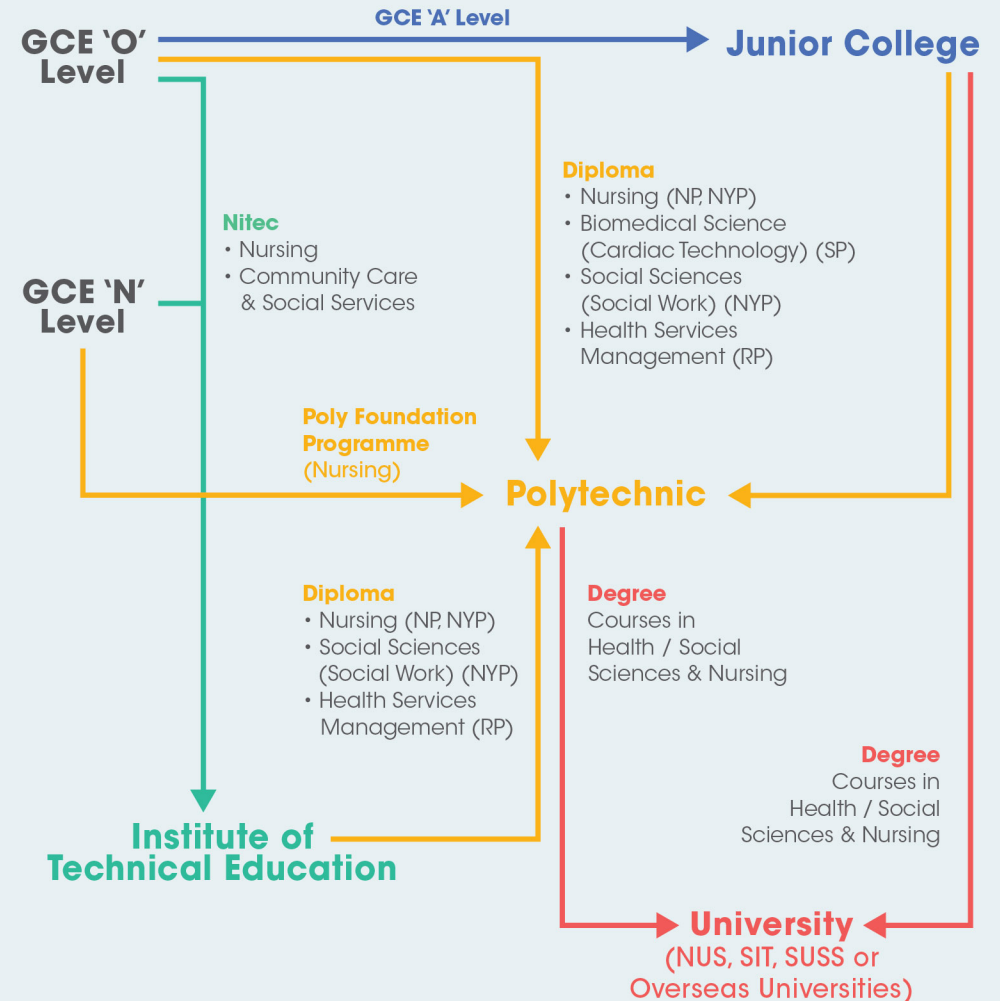
## Physiotherapist
