





Tampines Family Medicine Clinic (Tampines FMC), a multi-doctor general practice, provides a wide range of healthcare services conveniently located under one roof. Led by a team of experienced Family Physicians, the clinic provides doctor's consultation for both acute conditions and chronic diseases for children, adults and the elderly.

The Tampines FMC offers personalised, comprehensive, continuing and preventive medical care. Patients are encouraged to make an appointment to see a doctor and they can choose to see the same doctor for their subsequent visits.

Services include:

- 1. Acute care eg fever, cough, diarrhoea, vomiting, skin conditions, painful/itchy conditions, STDs, etc
- 2. Chronic disease management
- **3.** Health screening
- **4.** Home care service
- **5.** Children and adult vaccinations including HPV, flu, chickenpox
- **6.** Travel vaccination and advice
- 7. Onsite laboratory tests e.g. dengue, HbA1c, cholesterol, glucose
- **8.** Women's health eg. menstrual conditions, menopause, contraception, pap smear
- **9.** Men's health eg. andropause, impotence, prostate conditions, hair-loss, etc
- **10.** Minor surgery
- 11. Statutory Medical Examinations e.g. application for work permit or foreign domestic worker, driver's license, outward bound school (OBS), pre-enrolment for Polytechnic and University etc

Use of Medisave for your Healthcare

You can use your family member's or your own Medisave, of up to \$\$400 per Medisave account a year.

The Chronic Disease Management Programme (CDMP) allows Medisave use for the following 19 chronic diseases and vaccinations: -

Diabetes, hypertension (high blood pressure), lipid disorders (eg, high cholesterol), stroke, asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), schizophrenia, major depression, bipolar disorders, dementia, osteoarthritis, anxiety, benign prostatic hyperplasia, parkinson's disease, nephrosis/nephritis, epilepsy, osteoporosis, psoriasis or rheumatoid arthritis.

Vaccinations include childhood vaccines, hepatitis B and cervical cancer vaccinations, influenza and pneumococcal vaccinations.

Flexi-Medisave for the Elderly

If you are 65 years old and above, you may claim up to \$200 per year on top of existing subsidies, for treatment at Tampines FMC.
